Preschool drop off for us is slowly getting easier as it's been a crazy first term. We have been sick for a couple of weeks shortly after starting and their favourite teacher has since left. We have chosen to do one pink and one purple which I think the preschool appreciated, however the girls are still getting upset when they are called the wrong name - which is completely understandable. This week we also switched it up and swapped shirts to trick the teachers (I feel they should know their little personalities by now). Last year, I was diagnosed with an auto-immune disease Hashimoto, along with low iron and low vitamin D. With the help of my naturopath I have been on all sorts of herbs and supplements to try and bring my levels back into the normal range. My aim is to not be medicated on a thyroid supplement for the rest of my life, so I'm trying to put in the hard work where I can. I have also started eating gluten free and dairy free where possible, I'm not as strict as I should be but I can certainly notice a difference in the way I feel.

My favourite podcast at the moment is 'Too Peas in a Podcast'. Two twin mammas who both have met through multiple birth playgroups and both sets of their twins have additional needs. I find both ladies very honest, funny and relatable, have a listen and I hope you can laugh and cry along with them.

SSMBA have been fortunate enough to be very busy with lots of events in February and March, please note that there are no scheduled events for April because of Easter and of course more importantly school holidays. I hope everyone stays safe over the holiday break and enjoys eating lots of chocolate over Easter. I know our house is very excited for the Easter bunny to arrive, I have even overheard a little plan to stay up late and capture the Easter bunny to get some more chocolates.




